# CMG CONNECT Safe Haven Online Training

VIRTUS training is being replaced with CMG Safe Haven online training. This program consists of 3 vignette-style online training videos and includes a criminal background check. <u>Live training will no longer be offered. All Safe Environment training will only be available online.</u>

- All school volunteers, chaperones of field trips, and others who have regular contact with students (eating lunch on campus, visiting the classroom) are required to have Safe Environment training.
- All up-to-date VIRTUS trained individuals are covered with their training. The 5-year anniversary date is still valid - when your anniversary date is met, you must go through CMG Safe Haven training.
  - As the VIRTUS 5-year anniversary date is met, you will need to log in to <u>CMGConnect</u> with your previous VIRTUS user ID and 1234 as the password.
- All new (non-VIRTUS trained) volunteers or regular visitors will complete the Safe Haven online training program instead of VIRTUS PGC training. You can access the training program at <a href="CMGConnect">CMGConnect</a>.



# Welcome back to School! We have a few friendly reminders as we are getting settled into the new school year:

- Please return all technology, handbook, and emergency forms to the office as soon as possible.
- The Friday letters, AR book finder, Mathletics, and other important links can be found on the school website or by clicking <a href="here">here</a>. Do not forget to check the Teacher Friday letters. They contain a lot of important information about what is going on in your child's classroom(s) each week.
- **Cell phone usage is prohibited while driving in the school parking lots.** Please be respectful and courteous to one another.
- Car line and prayer start earlier this year. Teachers will start helping students get out of their cars at 7:35. Prayer starts at 7:45. If you arrive at 7:50 or later, please drop off your student(s) at the front door of the school. To ensure everyone's safety, teachers must walk their students from Cargill Hall into school at 7:50.
- Is it important for all students to attend Mass on Fridays. If you are running late, bring your student to the office. They will meet with their class after Mass. DO NOT drop off the student in the church, it is disruptive to the Celebrant and it creates a safety issue for our students.
