Enrollment

The re-enrollment process for current students who will be returning for the 2024-2025 school year is open, students need to be re-enrolled to be placed in classes for the next school year. Don't miss St. Mary's Early Bird incentives. It is important that you complete the online re-enrollment as soon as possible so plans can be made for classes for next year.

⇒ Before Feb. 21,2025
 ⇒ Before March 28, 2025
 ⇒ Before April 25, 2025
 \$175/ student will be deducted from the registration
 \$100/student will be deducted from the registration fee.

- SMCS will continue to offer sibling discounts, \$700 per year, for every child enrolled full time after the first child. Tuition is calculated from the oldest to the youngest child.
